



## TITLE VI NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

The paragraph below will be inserted into all significant publications that are distributed to the public. The text will be placed on the agency's website. The version below is the preferred text, but where space is limited or in publications where cost is an issue, the abbreviated version can be used in its place.

*Waccamaw Regional Council of Governments (WRCOG) and The Grand Strand Area Transportation Study (GSATS) hereby gives public notice that it is the policy of the agency to assure full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and related statutes and regulations in all programs and activities. Title VI requires that no person in the United States of America shall, on the grounds of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from the participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity for which the WRCOG or GSATS receives federal financial assistance. Any person who believes they have been aggrieved by an unlawful discriminatory practice under Title VI has a right to file a formal complaint with WRCOG or GSATS. Any such complaint must be in writing and filed with the Title VI Coordinator within one hundred and eighty (180) days following the date of the alleged discriminatory occurrence.
